What Standards Are Available?

CICA has a negotiated agreement with Australian Standards provider SAI Global to offer a subscription to a suite of standards relevant for general use in the crane industry free of charge to CICA members.

The standards available through this agreement include design, safe use standards for cranes, as well as safe use / inspection criteria for lifting gear, as listed below:

- ◆ AS 1418 Crane, Hoist and Winches Design (part suite only)
- ◆ AS 2550 Crane, Hoist and Winches Safe Use (part suite only)
- ◆ AS 1353.2-1998 Flat Synthetic-webbing Slings
- ◆ AS 1666.2-2009 Wire Rope Slings
- ◆ AS 2740-2001 Wedge Type Sockets
- ◆ AS 2759-2004 Steel Wire Rope
- ◆ AS 3850-2013 Tilt Up Concrete Construction
- ◆ AS 4497.2-1997 Flat Synthetic-round Slings
- ◆ AS 4991-2004 Lifting Devices
- ◆ AS 2741-2001 Shackles
- ◆ AS 3775.2-2014 Chain Slings for Lifting Purposes—Grade T(80) and V(100) Care and Use

While the list of Standards are not comprehensive, the twenty-four available standards should be relevant in assisting members with the design and safe use requirements of their cranes and the service / inspection of their lifting equipment. These Standards can be viewed from any computer or device that has access to the internet. Several of these Australian Standards are under review with revisions out within the next 12-months. The CICA contract with SAI Global ensures that the most recent Standard is available for viewing.

How Are They Accessed?

The CICA Member Only Standards Subscription is accessed via a web portal accessed through the CICA Website Member Only Page.

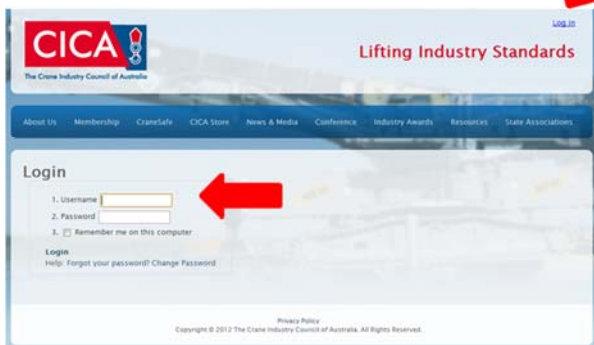


Figure 1: Log-in to the Member-Only Section

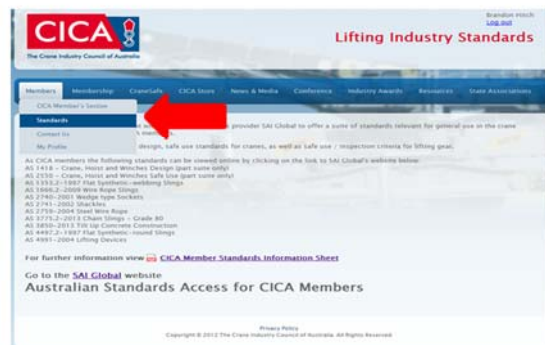


Figure 2: Click on the dropdown menu for "Standards"

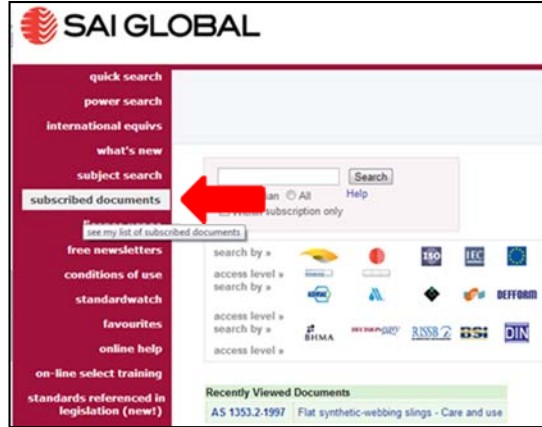


Figure 4: On the left-hand side of the page is a filter for "subscribed documents". Click on this link.

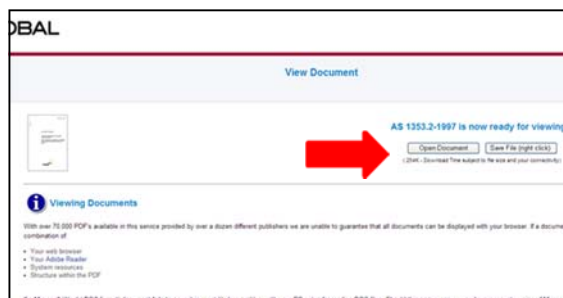


Figure 6: Click on "Open Document"

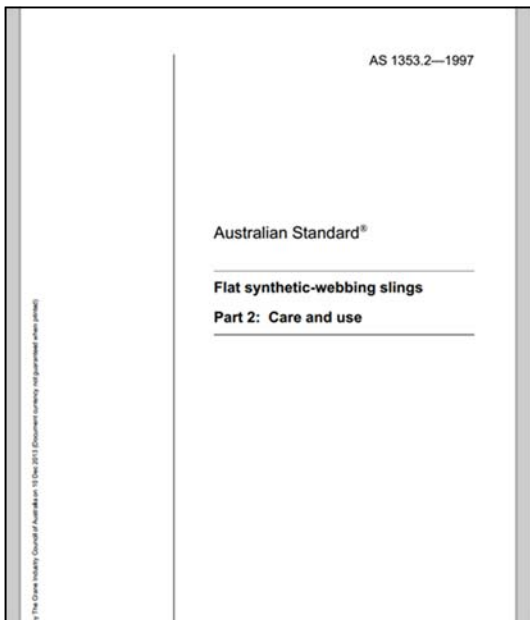


Figure 7: The Standard can be viewed
