

### TRAINEE ENROLMENT PROCESS

### EMPLOYER'S PROCESS

1. Once the trainee has paid the administration fee and has a signed training contract, the trainer will contact the employer.
2. Together, the trainer and employer negotiate the training plan and delivery method.
3. The employer will be requested to nominate an onsite supervisor who holds skills and licence in crane operations.
4. The trainer will attend the worksite to introduce the training process to the trainee and supervisor. The course content will be discussed and, where applicable, the below may be provided:

  - Learner Guides
  - Activity Books and suggested workplace activities
  - Skilled Personnel Career Log Book
  - RTO's Third party reporting documents(where required)
