Information for VCA Members on 4/5 Axle All Terrain Crane road access through Gazette notice – May 12th, 2014.

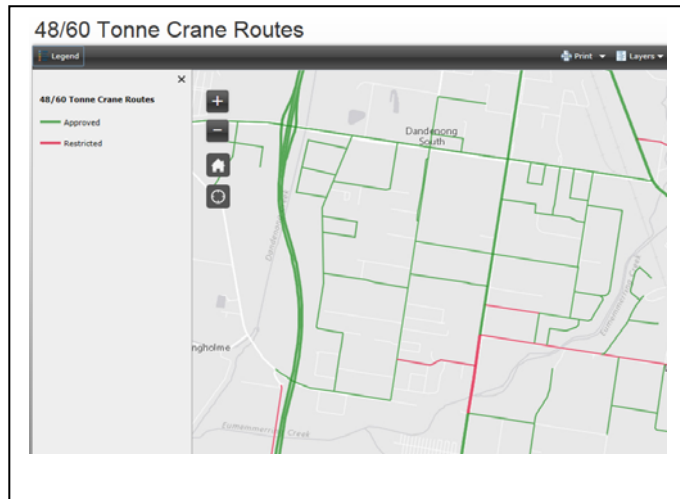
Dear VCA Member,

This is an informative guide to new road access conditions for 4/5 axle All Terrain Cranes.

Permits for these vehicles may not be required if travel is upon approved routes as indicated on a 'live' map that VicRoads has developed. If you have any doubts, contact VicRoads.



To see if the crane can travel without a permit, check on the VicRoads website. Click on the picture of the A/T Crane



If the intended route of travel is all green, one return trip can be made per day if the crane meets the guidelines of the Gazette notice – ie 12t/axle and minimum 2.68m ground contact width etc. Above picture is part of Dandenong.

If travel on a road that is not marked as Approved (green) is required, you must still obtain a permit for the required non green roads only from VicRoads as per normal.

Please be aware that IAP monitoring is now very active. Any non-conformances will be acted upon by VicRoads. The continuation of this access is based upon industry being able to do the right thing.
